Application Criteria

To be selected for a scholarship you must:

- 1. Be a US citizen or Green Card holder this is required to apply.
- 2. Be pursuing a degree in Food Science or Food Science related area (Dairy Science, Microbiology, Chemistry, Nutrition, etc)
- 3. Be attending school within the Chicago Section IFT boundaries or have a permanent address within the same boundaries (Applicable regions include the following zip codes: 60000-61999, 62300-62399, 62500-62799, 46300-46499)
- 4. Supply contact information (name, phone numbers, and e-mails) for two references. References must be a professor, instructor, teacher, advisor, or supervisor.
- 5. Provide an unofficial school transcript
- 6. Provide a copy of your college admission letter and your acceptance
- 7. Provide a copy of either your ACT or your SAT score.

 - b. Citizenship status
 - Student Enrollment Status Full or part-time student August 2021-May 2022
- 2. Institution (College/University) Information
 - a. Name, Address, Url, Admission contact
- 3. Current Academic Informaion
 - a. Current high school
 - b. GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
 - c. Class Rank
 - d. ACT or SAT score
 - e. Expected academic program major
- 4. Application Questions (250 words or less for each question)
 - a. Why do you want to pursue a career in the food industry?
 - b. Describe your volunteer and/or extracurricular activities in the past 3 years and share the impact of your contributions.
 - c. Describe any work experience or leadership experience in the past 3 years and how it has developed your leadership capabilities.
 - d. Describe one honor or award you have received in the past 3 years and explain why it is meaningful to you and your plans for your future.
 - e. Why should you receive a CFSF scholarship? What distinguishes you from other applicants? Share one quality, experience or skill that you believe sets you apart from other candidates and prepares you for a career in the food industry.
